Corrugated Cardboard (Double-walled cardboard), brown paper bags.	Flattened and dry – put in labelled gaylord (box) in recycling shed	Wet cardboard, box board, waxed cardboard, gooey pizza boxes.
All Other Paper All paper, including white and colored office paper, envelopes, fax paper, file folders, carbonless paper, sorted junk mail, magazines, phone books, box board and catalogs.	Paper-bagged or loose; window envelopes are okay. Mail must be opened; remove plastic stickers, cards, etc. – put in labelled gaylord (box) in recycling shed	Unbleached paper, carbon paper, transparencies, blueprints, stickers, construction paper or tape. No string or plastic.
Zero Sort the following:	Which means it does not have to be separated – it all goes into the Zero-Sort (recycling) roll-off.	
Glass - white, green, brown	Rinsed, no lids, all glass window glass, car glass.	No ceramics or blue glass.
Steel, Aluminum and Tin cans, pans, foil. Note: All metal can go in the metal dumpster – this saves us \$\$	Rinse and flatten; pie plates and foil are okay if clean.	Please rinse cans. No jar lids.
#1 Plastic (PETE) clear soda, juice, cooking oil, ketchup bottles, must have the #1 symbol.	Rinsed, NO CAPS, smashed.	Please rinse and take off caps.
#2 Plastic (HDPE) cloudy, colored, detergent, soap and shampoo bottles, milk, cider, water jugs, must have the #2 symbol.	Rinsed, NO CAPS, smashed, must have the #2 symbol.	Please rinse and take off caps. NO motor oil bottles, baby wipe boxes, food trays, tofu boxes or toys.
# 5-7 Plastics:	Rinsed, NO CAPS, smashed, must have the #'s 5-7 symbols.	Please rinse and take off caps. No plastic bags, no Styrofoam.

Paper is sorted into three gaylords in the recycling shed. All other recycling goes into the recycling roll-off.
